MEMBERS PRESENT: Mayor Ron Blachford, Aldermen: Jim Odegaard, Tony Rangel, Bob Steers, Jeff Swartz, Joe Zeller, and Alderwoman Tammy Lichty.

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Blachford called the meeting to order.

Pledge of Allegiance was said by all present.

AGENDA: Motion by Alderman Odegaard, seconded by Alderman Steers to approve the agenda. All members voted aye. Motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Alderman Rangel, seconded by Alderwoman Lichty to approve the minutes for the regular meeting held on March 15, 2021, All members voted aye. Motion carried.

DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

Ron Hoftiezer stated that he needs a value on the street sweeper. Motion by Alderman Rangel, seconded by Alderman Zeller to have the street committee research and give a written statement of the value of the 2003 Elgin Street Sweeper to surplus. WHEREAS, City is the owner of the following described real property located in the City of Miller, Hand County, South Dakota, referred to as:

East Second Avenue Right of Way, in Miller, Hand County, South Dakota; and

WHEREAS, Rulinkes are the owners of the following described real property in Miller, Hand County, South Dakota:

The South 70 feet of Lot 6, Block 1, Garlick's Addition to the City of Miller, according to the recorded plat thereof.

- 3. This grant of easement shall run with the land and shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their heirs, successors and assigns.




