CALL TO ORDER: Mayor McGough called the meeting to order.

Pledge of Allegiance was said by all present.

**AGENDA:** Motion by Alderman Hargens, seconded by Alderman Wetz to approve the agenda as amended to add DOLGEN Liquor License. All members voted age. Motion carried.
